### RESOLUTION OF PROTEST OF TRANSFERAL OF RETAIL CLASS “A” LIQUOR LICENSE FOR PETWORTH LIQUORS TO 3213 GEORGIA AVENUE, NW

**WHEREAS;** ANC 1A is gravely concerned that the operation of Petworth Liquors negatively impacts the peace, quiet, cleanliness, safety, and crime in the immediate vicinity;

**WHEREAS;** Petworth Liquors has applied to transfer their Retail Class “A” Liquor License from 3210 to 3213 Georgia Avenue, NW (License No.: ABRA-092503);

**WHEREAS;** The relocation of Petworth Liquors to a site adjacent to residential rowhouses will exacerbate the negative impacts this business already has on the surrounding residents;

**WHEREAS;** The applicant has a growing history of ABRA violations, including recent events on January 4, 2012, April 20, 2013, and May 8, 2013, which violate their Settlement Agreement, specifically DC codes §25-446, §25-723, and §25-741.

**WHEREAS;** The applicant has not formally committed to altering its operating practices to curtail loitering, public intoxication, graffiti, or ensuring the general public safety in direct proximity of the location;

**WHEREAS;** The applicant’s history of violating its Settlement Agreement and the DC code gives the Commission reservations that the owner and operator will operate in compliance with the existing or any revised settlement agreement; and;

**WHEREAS;** The residents within the affected area of the proposed location are opposed to the transfer of the Retail Class “A” liquor license and the operation of a liquor store given the proprietors record of violations.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED;** That notice be sent to ABRA stating that ANC1A hereby protests the transferal of Hundal, Inc.’s liquor license to 3213 Georgia Avenue, NW.
